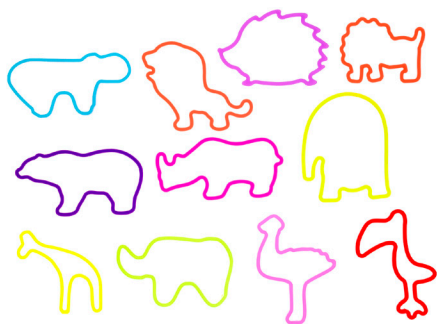


What is CPSIA?

- Enacted August 14, 2008 by the United States Congress in an effort to expand the scope of the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), particularly regulating products that are designed for children 12 years old and under.
- Covers all children's products bought or sold in the United States. Sets a stricter lead limit for children's products than for adult products.
- Bans select phthalates.
- Requires all children's products be tested and certified by an accredited and approved CPSC third-party laboratory.
- Total cadmium is not yet regulated by CPSIA. For soluble cadmium requirements please refer to our EN 71-3/ASTM F 963-08 bulletin.
